



SEASONAL GREENHOUSE

GENERAL PRODUCTION

This summary highlights the main components of Wagner's seasonal greenhouse general production positions, but is not inclusive of all activities that may be required. Employees may be transferred from one position to another position listed below as need arises.

SUMMARY OF AVAILABLE POSITIONS

1. SEED

- Plant seeds into trays by hand and/or by automated machine.
- Catch trays and stack.
- Label trays with accuracy.

2. SOILS/TRANSPLANT/CUTTINGS

- Ensure trays are filled with soil for the next stage in production.
- Transplant young plants into larger trays.
- Stick cuttings into soil following all hygienic protocols.

3. QUALITY CONTROL

- Digging – remove soil from empty tray cells.
- Patch trays – fill empty cells with plants.
- Grading – move plants to incorporate the same size plants in each tray.
- Trim cuttings using scissors, removing flowers/leaves, etc.

4. SHIPPING

- Load and unload trucks.
- Pull orders with accuracy for packing and shipping to customers.
- Assemble packing boxes.
- Transport trays for loading of product.

Other duties may be defined by your direct supervisor/manager.

REQUIREMENTS

- Perform all tasks within timeframe allotted.
- Must not be allergic to plants, dust and/or plant chemicals.
- Must be authorized to work in United States.
- Work as part of a team while observing all safety rules.
- Ability to work in varying temperatures and humidity.
- Ability to balance, reach and grasp while climbing on a step stool and/or ladder.
- Ability to crouch, grasp, and lift product above shoulders in order to lift product from the floor properly.
- Ability to be on feet while performing job responsibilities for up to 8 hours.
- Ability to step-up over piping; approximately 3 feet off the ground.
- Must have excellent hand/eye coordination.
- Bilingual a plus.
