#### FACILITIES MAINTENANCE TECHNICIAN

### **Position Summary**

The Facilities Maintenance Technician is responsible for the maintenance and repair of all buildings, greenhouses, residential houses, equipment, and related facilities.

#### **Core Expectations**

- Perform a variety of maintenance tasks—ranging from minor to complex—on facilities, buildings, residential houses, grounds, and equipment, including carpentry, plumbing, masonry, and painting.
- Repair and maintain pumps, motors, fans, louvers, roofs, doors, drains, septic systems, and organized storage areas.
- Operate heavy power-driven equipment such as trucks, loaders, and other maintenance and repair machinery.
- Perform routine cleaning of grounds, including lawn care and snow removal.
- Conduct preventive maintenance on all equipment.
- Maintain and repair the irrigation water distribution systems throughout the greenhouse facilities.
- Perform repairs on HVAC, mechanical, electrical, hydraulic, and plumbing systems.
- Be available for on-call emergency maintenance services to ensure continuous operation of essential greenhouse systems.
- Provide guidance and oversight to additional maintenance crew members as needed.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the Maintenance Supervisor.

#### **Core Competencies**

- Adhere to company policies and applicable laws.
- Demonstrate self-motivation and the ability to perform maintenance independently or as part of a team in a commercial greenhouse environment.
- Efficiently use various power and hand tools.
- Operate forklifts, front-end loaders, and electric carts safely and effectively.
- Follow oral and written instructions accurately.
- Communicate clearly and professionally in both written and verbal form.
- Establish and maintain effective working relationships with team members and other departments.
- Maintain a valid driver's license, reliable transportation, and a clean driving record.
- Exhibit strong critical thinking, troubleshooting, and problem-solving skills.

- Licensing Requirement: Must hold a minimum of a Minnesota 2C Boiler License, or obtain a Special Engineer License within six (6) months of employment and a 2C License within eighteen (18) months of employment.

#### **Experience / Education**

- High school diploma or equivalent required.
- Minimum of five (5) years of experience in general construction, maintenance, or repair work, including operation of a wide range of power-driven equipment.
- One (1) year of formal technical training preferred.

#### **Mental / Physical Requirements**

- Ability to lift and move up to 40 pounds occasionally, 20 pounds frequently, and 10 pounds constantly.
- Ability to balance, reach, and grasp while climbing ladders or step stools.
- Ability to crouch, lift, and raise materials overhead when required.
- Ability to stand for extended periods while performing job duties.
- Strong technical aptitude.

#### **Work Schedule**

- Full-time position requiring a minimum of 40 hours per week.
- Must be available to work Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., with additional coverage as needed.

#### **Working Relationships**

- Reports directly to the Maintenance Supervisor.
- Works closely with peers, other departments, and company staff.
